Pennsylvania's "first green affordable housing project"

Our design intention is simple: to efficiently provide dwelling that benefits occupants, neighbors, and the community; to provide houses that allow occupants to take pleasure in the everyday acts of dwelling. These same houses were designed to minimize their impact on pools of resources known to be finite. After one year of occupancy, energy cost averaged \$50 per month, per unit. The design has been recognized for excellence by the American Institute of Architects and the Green Building Association of Central Pennsylvania.
