



Harrisburg Midtown Arts Center

The Harrisburg Midtown Arts Center introduces a mixed-use arts program into three attached buildings, totaling roughly 28,500 square feet. The buildings aggregated over sixty years, beginning with the Albert Hummel Mansion on Third Street in 1867, the Hebrew Gym on Herr Street in 1924, and the 1927 Fraternal Order of the Orioles building, which features a pool in the basement and grand theater space on the second floor.

After renovation, the Arts Center offers a 400-seat/800-standing audience performance theater with VIP balcony, a cabaret stage, gallery, restaurant, outdoor café, bars, retail and arts management offices. The theater ceiling is modified to create an extraordinary acoustical environment while retaining original plaster detail. A separate swim and fitness club will occupy the original pool and locker room area in the basement.
