In anticipation of construction at the existing Carlisle campus, OPA planned and designed a \$2,000,000 renovation of another Carlisle building to serve as temporary campus. The 67,000 square foot former Regional United Telephone Company Building was built in 1952 in Georgian Revival style.

Its ADA compliant adaptive re-use transformed the office building to an educational facility that accommodates campus functions including a law library, classrooms, moot courtroom, offices, café and bookstore. The project design and construction was initiated in early 2006 and was completed in time for the fall 2006 semester.
