



Tower House

Sausalito, California - 2006

OPA designed additions to a 4-story house, constructed within the 22'x 22' square structure of a 1904 water tower in Sausalito. The structure was one of the few to survive the 1906 earthquake. The additions would extend the living and dining space on the second floor toward the view of Richardson Bay and Angel Island. The ground floor addition developed as a winter garden room. Blasen Gardens collaborated on the landscape design of the steeply sloping site.
